

Reserve 208GT Terms and Conditions

1. PEUGEOT WEBSITE ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The website <https://new208booking.peugeot.co.uk> (“**208 GT Line website**”) is owned by Automobiles Peugeot and hosted by Summit Media Limited of 12 Golden Square, Soho, London W1F 9JE. Automobiles Peugeot operates the 208 GT Line website on its own behalf and on behalf of Peugeot Motor Company PLC (“**Peugeot UK**”) and Peugeot UK’s Dealers (each a “**Dealer**”).

Connection and access to the 208 GT Line website requires your full and unconditional acceptance of all the provisions of these term and conditions.

2. RESERVATION PROCESS

You may use the 208 GT Line website to reserve a new Peugeot 208 GT Line only (“**vehicle**”). Reservations may only be made by individuals wishing to reserve a vehicle for domestic and private use only.

The vehicle is not yet available to order. The earliest forecast date for opening of orders is September 2019, but this is only an estimate.

The 208 GT Line website allows you to partially configure a vehicle by choosing:

- the desired powertrain (petrol /diesel / electric motor), and
- the desired colour.

Detailed configuration of options and equipment will only be possible once the vehicle is available to order from a Dealer.

If you decide to reserve a vehicle you will have the ability to choose which Dealer you would like to deal with (“**your Dealer**”). We will make the full list of Peugeot UK Dealers available for you to select from, so you can easily find the Dealers near you, if that is convenient for you, and we will highlight those Dealers nearest in location to your home address/postcode.

You will be invited to create an account and enter your contact details, including your e-mail address.

You may reserve a vehicle by clicking the “Reserve” button. If you reserve a vehicle on the 208 GT Line website, you are not making an offer to purchase a vehicle and this does not create a contract of sale.

3. PAYMENT OF RESERVATION FEE

Where you reserve a vehicle through the 208 GT Line website your Dealer you will be required to pay a refundable reservation fee of £500 using a valid Visa or MasterCard. No reservation can be made without payment of the reservation fee. The reservation fee will be

returned to you in full, whether you decide to order the reserved vehicle or not, as set out in condition 5 below.

Any card payment that your Dealer takes from you via the 208 GT Line website will be directed through a secure portal and your card details will not be stored by your Dealer or Peugeot UK. Any refund of the reservation fee will be made via the same secure payment portal and to the same card that you used to pay with. If your card has been cancelled, expired or has otherwise changed, please inform us immediately. If you fail to do this and a refund is made to your original card, you may need to coordinate with your bank or your payment services provider to obtain your refund.

You confirm that you are authorised to use the payment method that you provide to make payment. Peugeot UK, and/or your card issuer, may carry out security checking to confirm that this is the case. Peugeot UK will not pay interest on your reservation fee, in any circumstances.

4. AFTER YOU HAVE MADE A RESERVATION

If you successfully reserve a vehicle on the 208GT Site, you will receive an email confirming:

- receipt of your reservation and reservation fee
- the configuration of the vehicle reserved
- the contact details of your Dealer selected by you during the reservation process, and
- your ability to cancel your reservation at any time and receive a full refund of the reservation fee paid.

Your Dealer will contact you to make an appointment to take a test drive or place an order for the vehicle.

Appointments are subject to availability at your Dealer. If you are unable to attend your appointment, please let your Dealer know.

5. CANCELLATION / REFUND OF RESERVATION FEE

You may cancel your reservation at any time and receive a full refund of the reservation fee you have paid. To exercise this right of cancellation, you must notify us of your decision by either:

- accessing the 208 GT Line website and selecting the “my account” page, then clicking the “cancel my reservation” button’ or
- sending an e-mail to contact@new208booking.co.uk

Your reservation may be cancelled, in which case your reservation fee will be refunded, if you do not place an order for a vehicle within 30 days of the opening date for orders for the vehicle.

You will also receive a refund of the reservation fee from Peugeot UK if you place an order for a vehicle.

The refund of your reservation fee will be made within 7 working days of the date you cancel your reservation via the secure portal referred to in condition 3 above.

The refund will be credited to the same credit card you used to make the payment of the reservation fee.

6. ORDERS

The 208 GT Line website cannot be used to place orders for a vehicle. Orders can only be made with a Dealer.

If you decide to order a vehicle, you will need to finalise the configuration of the vehicle with your Dealer and place an order with your Dealer, and any order will be subject to your Dealer's terms and conditions of sale.

7. INFORMATION ABOUT THE VEHICLE

The 208 GT Line is still at pre-production stage. The detailed information and technical characteristics of the vehicle on the 208 GT Line website is therefore provisional and subject to change. Final information about the technical characteristics of the vehicle, including options and equipment, will be confirmed before you place an order for a vehicle with your Dealer.

Although Peugeot UK has made every effort to display colour options of the vehicle accurately, Peugeot UK cannot guarantee that any PC, laptop, tablet or phone will display the colours correctly.

8. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The content of the 208 GT Line website (which includes photographs, articles, drawings, animated sequences, digital audio or video recordings) is protected by copyright law. Certain content may be protected by the law on designs and trademarks including the "PEUGEOT" name, the "lion logo" (representing the PEUGEOT logo), the semi-figurative brand "GROUPE PSA", as well as the vehicle model brand or any other brand appearing on the 208 GT Line website.

The elements thus protected are the property of Automobiles Peugeot, its subsidiaries and / or third parties having authorised Automobiles Peugeot to exploit them.

10. COOKIES

11. ACCEPTABLE USE AND SECURITY

You agree that you will only access the 208 GT Line website Site for the purposes set out in these terms and conditions. You may only use the 208 GT Line website for lawful purposes.

You may not create hypertext links to the 208 GT Line website without the prior written consent of Peugeot UK.

12. OUR LIABILITY TO YOU

If we do not comply with these terms and conditions, we are responsible for loss or damage you suffer that is a foreseeable result of our breaching any term or our failing to use reasonable care and skill, but we are not responsible for any loss or damage that is not foreseeable. Loss or damage is foreseeable if either it is obvious that it will happen or if, at the time the contract is made, both Peugeot UK and you know it might happen, for example, if you discuss it with Peugeot UK and/or your Dealer before you place your reservation.

We do not exclude or limit in any way our liability to you where it would be unlawful to do so. This includes liability for death or personal injury caused by our negligence or the negligence of our employees, agents or subcontractors; for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; or for breach of your consumer rights in relation to the vehicle.

If you use any vehicle reserved via the 208 GT Line website for any commercial, business or re-sale purpose we will have no liability to you for any loss of profit, loss of business, business interruption, or loss of business opportunity.

13. OTHER TERMS

Peugeot UK may transfer its rights and obligations under these terms to another organisation.

If a court finds part of this contract illegal, the rest will continue in force. Each of the paragraphs of these terms and conditions operates separately. If any court or relevant authority decides that any of them are unlawful, the remaining paragraphs will remain in full force and effect.

Even if Peugeot UK delay in enforcing these terms and conditions, Peugeot UK can still enforce them later. If Peugeot UK does not insist immediately that you do anything you are required to do under these terms, or if Peugeot UK delay in taking steps against you in respect of your breach of any of these terms, that will not mean that you do not have to do those things and it will not prevent Peugeot UK taking steps against you at a later date.

Any changes Automobiles Peugeot and /or Peugeot UK may make to these terms and conditions in the future will be posted on this page. The new terms and conditions may be

displayed on-screen and you may be required to read and accept them to continue your use of the 208 GT Line website.

Automobiles Peugeot may suspend your access to the 208 GT Line website at any time, temporarily or otherwise, in the following cases: your infringement of these terms and conditions (without prejudice to any other rights and actions to which Automobiles Peugeot is entitled), technical problems linked to the infrastructure set up to put the 208 GT Line website online and for its operation and maintenance.

These terms and conditions are governed by English law and you can bring legal proceedings in respect of the products in the English courts. If you live in Scotland you can bring legal proceedings in respect of the products in either the Scottish or the English courts. If you live in Northern Ireland you can bring legal proceedings in respect of the products in either the Northern Irish or the English courts.

14. ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Alternative dispute resolution is a process where an independent body considers the facts of a dispute and seeks to resolve it, without you having to go to court. If you are not happy with how Peugeot UK or your Dealer have handled any complaint, you may want to contact the alternative dispute resolution providers Peugeot UK and your Dealer use.

Neither Motor Ombudsman nor the FOS will charge you for referring a dispute and if you are not satisfied with the outcome you can still bring legal proceedings.
